Charitable Giving History

In 2015 we began the practice of ‘Charitable Giving’ i.e. a donation to an agency in need and one from which we as parishioners did not benefit. For the two years we, as a Parish, made a donation of £5000 pa to Andrew House, Clevedon.

In April 2017 the AGM agreed to make a donation, for two years, of £4000 divided between the three charities listed below.
